~ MARKET GOAT SHOW RULES ~

Sunday, May 22, 2011 ~ 1 CJLA Show

Weigh In/Check In: Sat Evening during 2nd Boer show
and Sunday Morning from 8:00 am to 9:30 am

All Goats must be on grounds & weighed in by 9:30 am

Market Show will start at 10 AM with Showmanship ~ Seniors First

CLASSES: PROSPECT: 30-54 lbs, PROGRESS 55-74 lbs, MARKET 75 lbs and above

Notes: All animals will be weighed and entered into weight classes, broken down by Prospect, Progress and Market. There will be a Champion & Reserve in each division with an Overall Supreme. Some funds will be jackpotted back to the exhibitors. Reminder: This show is meant to help educate, evaluate and be a learning experience for all involved.

SANCTIONING ORGANIZATION: This show is a CJLA sanctioned open junior show.

ENTRY FEE: \$20.00 per entry

STALL FEE: BYOB – Bring Your Own Bedding

ENTRY DEADLINE: Entries Cash day of show!

LATE FEE: NONE! Entry forms and payment can be mailed early if you'd like. Otherwise, bring your goat and your cash on SUNDAY.

HEALTH REGULATIONS: Health Certificates are not required, (unless goats are from out of state) but all market goats must have Scrapie tags. Goats showing ANY visible signs the following will be removed and disqualified at the sole discretion of the show officials: CL, fungus, ringworm, sore mouth, and pneumonia or other disease, illness, or external parasites. PLEASE DON'T BRING IT TO THE SHOW. We RESERVE THE RIGHT to have a Licensed Veterinarian or show official present to inspect each animal before it crosses the scale. The sole discretion of the show officials and/or veterinarian will be final.

GENERAL RULES

- a. All JUNIOR market goat exhibitors must be 9-19 years old and under as of 1/1/11.
- b. The management reserves the right to change the show schedule and classes to improve the show.
- c. Each exhibitor must show his/her own animal (no handlers allowed) unless exhibitor has more than one goat entered in the same class or champion drive.
- d. Each exhibitor must be in control of his/her animal at all times.
- e. Market goats can be does or wethers (castrated males). No bucks allowed.
- f. Animals should be clipped and clean.
- g. Animals preferably will be disbudded, dehorned may have horns tipped; however, horns will be allowed.
- h. All goats must have their baby teeth to be eligible to show in the market show. No yearling teeth allowed.
- i. All paperwork and signed release must be completed before your animals can be weighed. Animals not entered CAN NOT be on the grounds without prior consent.
- j. All exhibitors are responsible for their own animals.
- k. The California Poppy Classic Boer Goat Show, Kern County Fairgrounds, Rebecca Cogswell, CJLA, or ABGA will NOT be held responsible for illness, injury, damage or loss of animals, person or property.
- l. You cannot show registered does in the market division and breeding show.
- m. No refunds will be made. No refund will be granted for disqualified entries or entries scratched if entries are pre entered and mailed.
- n. See breeding show rules for additional general rules.

CONFLICT OF INTEREST: An exhibitor shall not present an animal to be shown under a judge from whom it was purchased or possession taken within 90 days of show.

SHOWMANSHIP - The market goat showmanship is open to only market animals meeting the requirements for market entries. You MUST have an animal entered in the market goat show to be eligible to show in showmanship. Age breaks: Junior 9-12; Intermediate 13-15; Senior 16-19 as of January 1, 2010.

STALLS - There will not be assigned pens. First come first served. BYOB. Bring your own bedding. Stalls will be your responsibility to clean. This show is on the honor system. We will attempt to have a group to clean for you to pay if you choose. You may show out of your trailer if you wish, but please be respectful of where you park.
